Mac & Toz Alehouse closes and goes up for sale in Bridgeville

The owners of the Bridgeville restaurant Mac & Toz Alehouse have closed it in order to better focus on growing their two Bakn restaurants in Carnegie and Wexford.

Owners Randy Tozzie and Susan McMahon closed it and listed the restaurant for sale with Specialty Group, which is marketing the business, liquor licenses and the restaurant's furniture and equipment for sale with the expectation of working out a lease with the owner of the property, which is not for sale.

Tozzie, chef and owner, said in a prepared statement no longer has time for Mac & Toz, noting how the new Wexford location of Bakn "has taken off."

The Wexford location of Bakn is the second, following the original in Carnegie.

"My focus is to keep building the Bakn brand," he added of the demands of operating the two restaurants in different parts of the region.

Mac & Toz in Bridgeville recently closed and is up for sale.

Terri Sokoloff, president of the Specialty Bar & Restaurant Brokers division of Specialty Group, noted how the restaurant was remodeled a year ago and called it a turn-key corner space that includes an open kitchen and private dining space along with its renovated bar and dining room.

She called the decision to close and sell a strategic decision by the owners.
