Federal Galley operator to open new restaurant in the Strip

Federal Galley, established at Nova Place as an incubator for new restaurateurs, will soon land one of its operators into a new establishment of his own.

Chef Vincent Perri will operate at Federal Galley until April 28 and then work to establish Supper on Penn at 1211 Penn Avenue in the Strip District, according to an announcement by Specialty Group, which represented him in his search.

Perri is expected to be one of the first operators within the Federal Galley to establish a new, fully independent restaurant.

Look for Supper on Penn, which is a few blocks from the [Smallman Galley](#) affiliated with its Federal counterpart on the North Side, to focus on a made-from-scratch menu including health conscious items such as gluten free bread, tofu, and temp as well as suckling pork, bacon, and sausages, complemented by a full bar.

A graduate of Le Cordon Bleu, Perri has worked locally at Jacksons and Revel & Roost.

Terri Sokoloff, a principal of Specialty Group, said the timing made sense for Perri to take over what has been the long-established location of Crystal on Penn, whose owner is retiring.
