## Andora Fox Chapel to become Brick & Barrel

Andora Restaurant in Fox Chapel has been sold to Jeff Brungo and Chris Hildebrandt, who will debut a new concept and name at the location in January 2020.

The Specialty Group, which brokered the sale, announced the deal on Monday. In a press release, the Specialty Group said that the location would be used for a new restaurant called "Brick & Barrel." The restaurant will feature food cooked in a wood-fire brick oven, farm-to-table cuisine, more than 100 bourbons and a wide variety of craft beers, with a focus on those brewed locally. The menu will include burgers, Neapolitan pizza, entree salads, soups and desserts.

The release said the Cross Keys Inn building that housed Andora is a "historic landmark" with a large patio area that will be "a natural fit" for the Brick & Barrel concept.

Andora will remain open through the holiday season while the restaurant changes hands. The Andora location in Sewickley will remain open. The Specialty Group said the restaurant was sold by owner Michale McMullen so he could focus on other, unrelated business opportunities. The Specialty Group is also handling the sale of McMullen's restaurant Buford's Kitchen in downtown Pittsburgh.
