Dormont pizza operator to deliver wine by the bottle

Dormont restaurant Giovanni's Pizza & Pasta has been granted the right to sell and deliver bottles of wine to its customers in their homes by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.

Specialty Group, the restaurant services firm that is representing Giovanni's, said in an email that the PLCB has granted its two-phase application. The Pittsburgh Business Times reported on Aug. 26 that Giovanni's Pizza & Pasta has applied for one of the new wine-to-go permits. A new state law passed this summer allows licensees to sell up to four bottles of wine to go for the first time

with the new permits.

Specialty Group also sought a transporter-for-hire license for the restaurant, which will allow the restaurant to deliver the wine that it is now newly able to sell by the bottle.
