## New Pine Creek Public House to replace Thirsty's in Allison Park Plaza

The owners of the 69-year-old Kretzler's Tavern on Babcock Boulevard are confirmed to launch what one day may become another community dining institution.

According to an announcement by Specialty Group, Brandon Kretzler and his wife, Danielle Traeger are working to convert the former Thirsty's Bar & Grill in Allison Park Plaza into what they plan to call Pine Creek Public House, with a new menu, new garage doors to be installed to add open air dining and a new bar menu.

Terri Sokoloff, principal of Specialty Group, who brokered the sale of Thirsty's Bar & Grill to Kretzler and Traeger, said the "Thirsty's location checked all the boxes" for the experienced operators to launch the new concept, expecting the long-term success of Kretzler's should bode well for Pine Creek Public House.

The couple announced the coming of Pine Creek Public House with a new Facebook account for the restaurant.

The new restaurant is expected to open in Spring 2021.
