Arsenal Bowl goes up for sale on Butler Street in Lawrenceville

Arsenal Bowl, a Lawrenceville institution since the Great Depression, is up for sale.

Ross-based Specialty Group announced it has begun marketing the 20,000-square-foot property, which has long been a focal commercial anchor in the 9th ward of Butler Street's business district.

Owned by Paul Buncher since 1981, Arsenal has survived and thrived by cultivating the traditional league bowling clientele while also offering more of a nightclub appeal, hosting live bands and DJs and attracting movie stars in town for various film productions, including Tom Hanks and Bryan Cranston.

In its announcement, Speciality noted the ownership is reaching retirement age after a "record year" in 2019 in which the business has come through the pandemic.

The facility includes 22 lanes, a full-service bar with a commercial kitchen as well as space for live entertainment. The sale includes all furniture, fixtures and equipment.

The sale is for the business. The real estate, which includes a collection of storefronts on Butler Street, is not for sale.
