## Pine Creek Public House to replace burger joint in Gibsonia

The owners of the 72-year-old Kretzler's Tavern are poised to open a second location of their new restaurant, Pine Creek Public House.

Owners Brandon Kretzler and his wife Danielle Traeger debuted their first location of Pine Creek Public House in the former Thirsty's Bar & Grill in Allison Park Plaza in late 2020 and are now working to open their second location for the restaurant since the pandemic began.

According to an announcement by Specialty Group, which represented the operator in the deal for the new location as well as for the liquor license, Pine Creek Public House is set to take the place of the former Stack'd in Gibsonia at 5055 William Flynn Highway.

It's a big restaurant totaling 7,800 square feet, according to the announcement.

Terri Sokoloff, a principal of Specialty Group who represented Pine Creek Public House owners in taking over the former Stack'd space, said in a prepared statement that "the couple's experience and longevity in the North Hills made this opportunity a natural fit for expansion."

The new location for Pine Creek Public House is expected to open in late fall after the transfer of its liquor license.
